

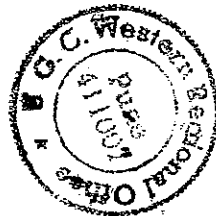

11) Whether the objectives were achieved - Yes

The basic goal of research project is to study the factors influencing origin and development of slums in six urban areas in the Beed district. There are regional variations of factors influencing origin and development of slums in urban centers according to its ranks. The pull and push factors are more active in origin and development of slums in urban areas. There are global and temporal variations of location origin and development of slums in six urban centers in Beed district. Parali-33, Beed-20, Ambejogai-12 having the high number of slums located near the market area, MIDC area, river-bank, road side. All most more than 90% slums are developed on municipal open space and government land.

Large scale rural urban of slums in all urban centers in Beed district. Transport and communication facilities, easy job in urban area, high wage in urban area, free land for shelter, relatives, social factors are responsible for pull the rural dwellers in urban slums in study region. Among the push factors from rural to urban are infertile soils, drinking water, low wage rate in rural area, low job opportunities in a study region. Georai, Majalgaon, Kez a small towns with less number and low growth rate of slums while in Beed, Ambejogai, Parali with high rate of slums development. This is due to job opportunities in these cities.

12) Achievement From the project-

i) There are variations of slum development in study region.

Beed, Ambejogai, Parali - High development of slums.

Kaiz, Majalgaon, Georai with lower development of slums

ii) Push and pull factors acting to develop slums in Beed District.

Pull factors - rural to urban migrations. Transport and communication, easy job, high wage rate, free land for slums, social factors pull the rural population in urban area develop slums.

Push factors- Rural to urban migration, relief, natural calamities, low jobs, low wage rate, social factors, push the rural population to urban area.

13) Summary of the Project -

Beed district is one of the developing district in Maharashtra region of Maharashtra. Geographical environment of Beed district influence lower development of urban centers. There are only seven urban areas i.e. Beed city, Parali vajinath, Ambejogai, Georai, Kaiz, Majalgaon and Dhanur. Dhanur urban area not have a single slum area as municipal record.

Beed city 20, Parali 33, Ambejogai 12, Georai 4, Majalgaon 3, Kaiz 4 slums are distributed in these urban area. It is difficult task to collect authentic data for research to gain our objectives. With the help of door to door survey with the help of questionnaire, expert

interviews, field observation, personal visits are the main source of primary data for this research project.

In the study region large rural to urban migration. In this study the important pull factors rural to urban migration are, development of transport network, easy job in urban centers, high wedge rate in urban area, easy free land for housing low cost houses, urban facilities attracting rural population in Beed, Parali, Ambejogai cities. In the survey it has been noted that continuous occurrences of climatic hazards badly influence agricultural production and rural to urban migration starts. Most of the slums dwellers are working as construction workers, watch man, security services, domestic work, porters, feriwale, Golawala, Bhelpuri centers, waiters, Lotgudi wala etc. work. Slum dwellers are the service providers to urban population. In the study region, relief, soil types, hazards, drinking water problems lower job opportunities, low wedge rate social factors are the push factors rural to urban migration.

In the study region almost go to slums are located on government land and municipal open space. Beed, Ambejogai, Parali urban centers implemented government scheme like housing, slum roads, infrastructure facilities in various slums in study region. Most of the slum dwellers are burden over urban amenities and so it creates number of problems. Indira Avas Yagna, Hudco project, Ramabai housing scheme etc schemes should be implemented in the study region.

#### 14) Major Finding and suggestions-

##### **FINDINGS :**

- Beed District is one of the low urban population district in Maharashtra having 17.74% population living in urban area. Among the urban is an urban centre 16.60 % of urban population is living in slums. Regional variations in environmental factors are responsible for origin and development of slums in the study region. The push factors like unsuitable physiography, unfertile soils, uncertainty of rainfall, natural hazards, low wedge rate in homeland, low job opportunities in homeland, accute shortage of drinking water are the major factors responsible for rural population to immigrate in the urban area. The second sets like pull factors available in urban area easy job opportunities, high wedge rate,



transport and communication, economic condition, urban life attraction and amenities, relatives are responsible for origin and development of slums.

- In the intensive fieldwork it has been marked that in large cities like Beed, Parali, Ambejogai sizable numbers of facilities immigrated in these cities from Marathwada and Vidarbha region. During the field survey it has noted that due to low job opportunities, low wedge rate, and acute drinking water problem in Vidarbha and Marathwada rural area large scale immigration from these areas. All these peoples are settled in large cities.
- The inter regional immigration of tribal in small towns are the common phenomenon. In the field survey of slums door to door survey among the tribal shows that they have live their homeland due to uncertainty of rainfall, lower agricultural production, low wedge rate natural hazards and acute shortage of drinking water. The flow of tribal population from urban area as well as in rural area is continuous and in future it create socio-economic problems in tribal region of Sahayadri Mountain.
- In the study region about 36.36% slums are located on government land, 55.84% slums are located on municipal land and only 7.80% slums are located on private land. In the study it has been observed that most of immigrants having from low income group so they prefer cheap and free land for accommodation that is easily available government land. They establish zopadi on land afterward they develop into house.
- In the urban area high land cost is main factor for development of slums. In the field study Beed, Parali, Ambejogai, Georai having high land cost and so in these city large size and large numbers of slums can be observed.
- In the study human tendency to save time, energy, and capital they prefer to settled near the place of work. Recently developed slums are located and established near the MTDC, market, and transportation area. During the survey it has marked that the labours from MIDC, market has settled in near by slums. Old slums are located near road site.
- It is very difficult to get the information and data about the functions of slums but door to survey noted that 96 % slums perform a functions like residential and source of unskilled labours.
- The town planning department has done planning for amenities like drinking water, roads, electricity, market, schools, recreational, sewage water plan are for their urban

population. The large-scale immigrants in the slums are disturbing the planning and act as burden an urban amenity. The illegal hutment's, illegal water connection, illegal electricity supply, are reasons for environmental pollution and create socio-economic problems in the urban area.

- In the region in Majalgaon, Kez, Parali town peoples tendency to sale their own houses located in the heart of the city or near by homeland house with high cost and construct illegal houses on government land. This problem is increasing day by day in the study region.
- In the study region towns like Beed, Majalgaon and Parali the immigrants from Marathwada lives in slums during the winter and summer season and migrated in working rainy season in Marathwada for agricultural work. They occupied the houses in the slums.
- Large and speedy growths of slums are the main problems in the region. Government and Municipality made planning for this problem.

#### **PLANNING, SUGGESTIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS :**

- Immigration planning will be done by government. The detail survey about the source places of immigrants, causes of immigration, impact of emigration of homeland, planning for to stop such large scale emigration from rural to urban area. If it essential need of skilled and unskilled labour in urban area immigration planning will be done by government or social organization or municipality. Job opportunities in the rural area should be increase, infrastructure amenities should be provided in rural area to stop such large scale rural to urban migration. The local rural resources can be utilized properly and socio-economic balance can be maintain and it is useful for proper planning for India.
- In the field observation and interview of expert it has been mark that slum dwellers make foregoing. In Beed city, Parali city, Municipality has provide row houses for slum dwellers in the survey it has been noted that the original row houses owner sale the houses and again settled in new slum area of Beed and Parali city. To overcome this problem municipality should provide identity card computation of Adhar Card, Bio-metric

system to the slum dwellers that will be the permanent. The up to date records about row houses can help to overcome this problem.

- Government of India, Maharashtra Government is implementing various projects to improve the slum life in India. Indira Awas Yojana, Gharkul Yojana, MHADA, HDFC, HUDCO project should be properly implemented in the area. Beed, Parali, Ambejogai Municipal Corporation has implemented this project. Mass programme for the slums should be implemented in every town in the study region. To provide row houses, various amenities, certainly help to improve the living quality of slum dwellers in the study region.

15) Contribution to the Society-

This basic as well as applied research project is very useful for rural and urban society in India. Today Beed district is one of the leading district in Maharashtra region. The continuous rural to urban migration influence formation of urban slums. The push and pull factors marked for migration is very useful for slum planning in India.


