The feedback analysis and report prepared by the IQAC was tabled in the College Development Committee Meeting held on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> September 2021 at 2.30 pm at the college. Dr. Lahade Mrulidhar has explained the entire reports received from the students, Teachers, and Alumni to the meeting. The trustee members and other members from the society, research, industries, Alumni were appreciated the role played and initiatives taken by the IQAC. They said that the quality enhancement initiatives adopted by the college are good and enjoyed by all the stakeholders. The stakeholders mentioned a few suggestions, and the CDC committee chairperson suggested the following issues raised by the students' teachers. Alumni are considered favorably, and such facilities will be provided to the students immediately.

- 1. To purchase ICT-enabled tools as early as possible.
- 2. To conduct online lectures as per the university guidelines.
- 3. To conduct online webinars on the Covid-19 pandemic situation
- 4. To motivate the students and general people to wear face masks, wash hands frequently by using sanitizers, and maintain social distance at public places.
- 5. To help needy people by giving them food, clothes, medical help.
- 6. To help Covid\_19 patients and their family members during the pandemic situation
- 7. To be aware the people about the precautions during the lockdown.

All the above issues raised by the stakeholders were discussed in detail. After the thorough discussion, the chairperson said to concentrate on the matters raised and implement them systematically. The CDC assigns the duties to the principal, head of the departments, NSS program officers, Director of Physical Education, and Librarian to be prepared budget estimates and put for the sanctioning purpose to the principal. On behalf of the CDC, the principal will sanction the specific budget estimates with the prior permission of the Chairman of the Trust. It was resolved unanimously by the CDC members.
